The A.K.C. will collect the above fees for each 1st Entry of a dog & each Additional Entry of the same dog in regular & non-regular recordable single entry classes in all A.K.C. Licensed & Member Club Events. Event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all fees for the A.K.C. & payment of all fees to the A.K.C. as stipulated in AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Ch 11, Sec 2

- . NO STROLLERS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE GROOMING AND SHOW AREAS.
- The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of
 disease, viciousness or any other cause, and no person shall have any claim or recourse against the club or
 any official thereof.
- There will be no drilling or intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises. NO DOUBLE HANDLING will be permitted at this show. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Show Committee.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
 There is no provision for unentered dogs at this show. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be picked up at the show, none will be mailed.
- All awards will be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging, to the person exhibiting the dog
 and that person shall be considered the rightful winner of the award. The Show Secretary should be advised
 of any award discrepancies.
- Effective January 1, 2015 -- USE OF RAMPS: A Judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent / show secretary prior to judging. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

SIBERIAN HUSKIES ARE NOT A RAMP OR TABLE DESIGNATED BREED AND MAY ONLY BE EXAMINED ON THE GROUND

Ramps can be used in an emergency situation to judge any breed. In an emergency situation an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

SIBERIAN HUSKEY CLUB OF AMERICA POLICY:

ALL ENTRIES IN SLED DOG & SLED BITCH CLASSES MUST BE INTACT SLED DOGS SLED BITCHES

RULES (Revised March 2016):

- Entry must be an American Kennel Club or Canadian Kennel Club registered Siberian Husky (eligible under Chapter 15, Section 1, AKC Rules Applying to Registration & Dog Shows).
- 2 There will be a class for dogs and a class for bitches. At the direction of the Show Chair additional classes may be offered based on the requirements of the Sled Dog Degree Program.
- ENTRY FEE IS \$30.00 FOR SLED DOG / SLED BITCH CLASSES AS A FIRST / ONLY **ENTRY OR FREE AS AN ADDITIONAL ENTRY**
- To qualify for entry in the Sled Dog Class the dog must have completed one of the following three requirements:
 - During the previous racing season, the applicant must complete ten (10) heats on snow with a minimum of four (4) miles per heat or the total miles per season not being less than 48 miles. Of the 48 miles up to 12 miles (25%) can come from Dryland Rig Races but the applicant must complete at least two (2) heats with a minimum of three (3) miles per heat. Dryland races must be on rigs. Rigs used must meet the definition of rig as defined by ISDRA under Dryland Races Rules. All races both snow and dry land must be under the direction of a Recognized Race Giving Organization with rules and recorded results. A Race Season is from April 1 to March 31 of the following year.
 - Entries who complete five (5) years in competition where the above rules are met shall be automatically qualified for the Sled Dog Class. A certificate of proof may be issued by the Chair of the Working Committee if the 5 years of proof of competition records are sent in.
 - Entries who have been awarded an SHCA Sled Dog Certificate, either SD, SDX, or SDO, and are additionally eligible for entry in a conformation class at an AKC event, are eligible to compete in the Sled Dog Class.
- SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS / BITCHES ARE NOT EXHIBITED IN THE SLED DOG / SLED 5. BITCH CLASSES AS REQUIRED BY THE SHCA STANDING RULES.

A list of races in which the dog competed, or a copy of the five year certificate or a copy of the Sled Dog Degree must be sent to the Show Secretary when entry is made. Proof of qualification must be available at ringside with one of these shown if challenged.

The Show Secretary shall request the following be provided with each entry to the Sled Dog Class: Each dog's AKC Registered Name, AKC Registration Number, Sex, Race and Date of Race, miles per heat and total miles - or 5 year proof certificate - or copy of the Sled Dog Degree.

AWARDS OF MERIT:

Specialty # 1 and Specialty # 2

In addition to selecting Best of Breed & Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, the judge will select Award of Merit winners. The number selected will be equal to ONE AWARD OF MERIT FOR EVERY 10 DOGS PRESENT IN THE BREED RING. There is no requirement for distribution of these awards between sexes and will be awarded in no particular order.

BEST IN BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES:

Specialty # 1 and Specialty # 2

Chosen from 1st Place Winners of the Bred By Exhibitor Classes: Puppy & Adult (Dogs & Bitches)

BEST IN SLED CLASSES:

Specialty # 1 and Specialty # 2

Chosen from 1st Place Winners of the Sled Classes (Dogs & Bitches)

OFFERED AT SPECIALTY # 1 ONLY

Owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be the owner of the get. The stud dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. THE GET MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS IN THIS SHOW. Judging to be on the merits of the get only.

The stud dog may be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes at this show, or if it is a Champion of Record, in the Best of Breed Competition (with payment of the appropriate Entry Fee for that class) PLUS Stud Dog as an "Additional Class" (with an additional Entry Fee of \$25.00) If entered in Stud Dog Class ONLY, Entry Fee is \$30.00

BROOD BITCH CLASS same as for the stud dog except

substitute brood bitch for stud dog and produce for get.

NOTE: Chapter 11, Section 8, AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows provides that castrated males may be entered as Stud Dog and spayed females may be entered as Brood Bitch.

BRACE CLASS Fee is \$25.00 as a unit Effective 1/1/05 -- Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs in the Brace must have at least one common owner.


